Project Progress During June 2019

For regular, updated information on the various projects under construction to create Bois d'Arc Lake and deliver its water, visit the recent updates page on boisdarclake.org.

Work completed over the past month (view the June report) includes:

- Building the lake dam, which currently stands around 17 feet tall and 500 feet wide.
- Pouring concrete for reservoir's spillway (to return lake water to Bois d'Arc Creek) and raw water pump station (10 of 33 pours complete).
- Working around the clock to finish tunneling so crews can begin to lay the raw water pipeline.
- Continuing stream restoration and start of planting native grassland cover crops in mitigation areas.


