NTMWD Board Sees Work in Action

It's always rewarding for our Board of Directors to see first-hand the exciting progress on our construction. On July 16th, the NTMWD Board of Directors did just that, catching a piece of the action as work continues on Bois d'Arc Lake.

"The construction site is so mammoth in proportion that it is hard for anyone to conceive of it unless you've seen it... The size of the overall project is just mind-boggling," shared Board President Don Gordon (Garland).

"This is very exciting," agreed Larry Parks, Board Vice President (Rockwall). "We've worked on this for 13 years. We're a couple years now from bringing water to our citizens in the northeast area in Texas of about 1.7 million people... What makes me most proud is the legacy of water in Texas—giving back to our families and our grandchildren (generations to come)."



Project Progress During July 2019

For regular, updated information on the various projects under construction to create Bois d'Arc Lake and deliver its water, visit the Project Reports page on boisdarclake.org.

Work completed over the past month includes:

- Building/connecting sections of the lake dam.
- Increasing height of intake tower walls and working on the conduits to move lake water through the tower (to be pumped out for treatment).
- Continued pouring of concrete for all buildings of the Leonard Water Treatment Plant.
- Final preparations for installation of the raw water pipeline to carry water from Bois d'Arc Lake to the Leonard Water Treatment Plant.
- Placing substructure/columns and laying deck panels for the new FM 897 bridge.
- Building bridges and paving county roads, with three currently near completion.
- Continuing stream restoration, planting grassland cover crops, plowing and herbicide treatments in mitigation areas.
