

Bois d'Arc Lake eNewsletter: Updates on Work Underway

Bois d'Arc Lake Website Launched

Our new website on the Bois d'Arc Lake project was launched just last month with additional information on Texas' newest lake coming to Fannin County.

We will update this site regularly with any additional information on construction activities, future lake benefits and eventual recreation opportunities. We will also be posting regular monthly reports on project progress to the site (see below).

Bois d'Arc Lake Monthly Reports

March's report is now online. Some highlights of work underway include:

- Ongoing construction of the new FM 897 bridge and spreading of earth for the roadway.
- Completing the second concrete pour for a 110-foot intake tower to collect and move water from the future lake to the pump station, where it can be moved to treatment.
- Planting of approximately 1,235,996 new trees by mid-March at a designated mitigation area.


Lake Facts at a Glance
